


SERVICE NOTES

SPINDLE, GEAR & KEY

The Spindle #853625 is currently being manufactured without the keyway. The keyed spindle will be available until stock on this type is used up. To use the keyless spindle, discard the key and press the gear onto the spindle. An arbor press is necessary for this assembly. When the gear is pressed onto the spindle, the nut, spacer, and O-ring are no longer necessary. Replacement gears will still incorporate a keyway for use on either keyed spindles or spindles without the keyway.

FLANGE NUT

Flange nut currently supplied with Backup Pad (Ref. 85) does not fit on these units. "Use Ref. 81.

ARMATURE PINION & GEAR REPLACEMENT

Original units were built with the armature pinion hobbed into the armature shaft, requiring replacement of the armature and gear in the event of pinion or gear failure. Currently we are supplying the armature pinion as a separate part. When replacing the early type non-replaceable pinion armature, it will also be necessary to replace the gear set (Ref. 31A) as outlined below. After the conversion it will only be necessary to replace the gear set in the event of gear failure.

PINION SPACER & GEAR SET - MODEL 470

The current Gear Set #867097 used in the Model 470 incorporates a spacer to be installed to the rear of the Pinion which acts as a Slinger. The Spacer #869285 is supplied with Gear Set #867097. Gear Sets received without the Spacer are acceptable and may be used.
